There will be a **Second Collection on Good Friday for the Holy Land**– **The Pontifical Good Friday for the Holy Land Collection**– offers support of the Holy Places, but above all for those pastoral, charitable, educational and social works which the Church supports in the Holy Land for the welfare of their Christian brethren and of the local communities.
