

Sunday, March 12, is the beginning of **Daylight Savings Time**. Clocks should be set **FORWARD** one hour before going to bed Saturday night. Also change the batteries in your smoke alarms/CO monitors and in the flashlights by your beds.

Lenten Guidelines for Mass:

Violet is the liturgical color of Lent. The Fourth Sunday of Lent is Laetare Sunday; rose vestments may be worn.

Flowers are not permitted, except on Laetare Sunday. These should be in moderation.

The Gloria is omitted during the season of Lent, except on the Solemnity of Saint Joseph (March 20) and the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord (March 25).

The Alleluia is not permitted to be said or sung during Lent. Refrain from choosing hymns that contain the word Alleluia.
